3. President's Report: Tony Sprackett

Submitted. Immediate neighbours of the My Place Shelter at the Boys and Girls Club are comfortable with the activities there. The shelter presently houses 40 residents and has 60 on the waitlist, having been moved mostly from Tent City. Thanks and acknowledgement given to Councillor Charlayne and Mike Hill.

The Building Committee has approved the purchase of a projection screen for the Paul Phillips Hall, ahead of purchasing a new projector. More and more renters of the Hall have been asking for a projection screen over the past years. Clive Beal spoke on behalf of PACS about the poor quality of light in the Paul Phillips Hall. It was determined that the window above the back doors need only be covered during performances, and that the curtain should be removed for PACS in future.
